# SS. Peter and Paul Music

Many of our foreparents brought with them from Europe old folk melodies that were sung in conjunction with the Orthodox Church's liturgical year. While not officially church music, these songs were the people's way of celebrating the feasts after the services had been completed in their homes and villages. "O Who Loves, Nicholas the Saintly" ("O kto, kto ....") comes to mind as perhaps the most well-known example of these informal hymns.

This year, the feast of SS. Peter and Paul, the leaders of the Apostles, falls on Sunday, June 29<sup>th</sup>. These saints were and are quite popular among our people. Just think of the many churches and men and boys who bear their names. The arrangement on the next page, in simple two-part harmony, is an old folk melody celebrating this feast day and may be sung by a youth choir or even by the entire congregation. Feel free to make many copies.
